RESOLUTION NUMBER

(27th JUL. 2026)

By which a public call is issued for the selection of members of the Territorial Planning Council of the Departmental Archipelago of San Andres, Providence, and Santa Catalina Islands

THE GOVERNOR OF THE DEPARTMENTAL ARCHIPELAGO OF SAN ANDRES, PROVIDENCE, AND SANTA CATALINA, in exercise of her legal and regulatory powers, particularly those conferred by Article 340 of the Political Constitution, Law 152 of 1994, Departmental Ordinance 007 of 2005, and,

CONSIDERING

Whereas Article 340 of the Constitution establishes that the territorial entities shall have a Planning Council composed of representatives of territorial entities and of the economic, social, ecological, community and cultural sectors, which shall have a consultative nature and shall serve as a forum for discussion of the Departmental Development Plan.

Whereas Article 2 of the Constitution provides that "The essential purposes of the State is (...) to facilitate the participation of all persons in the decisions that affect them and in the economic, political, administrative, and cultural life of the Nation (...)."

Whereas Article 34 of Law 152 of 1994 provides that "The Territorial Planning Councils at the departmental, district, or municipal level shall be composed of persons appointed by the Governor or Mayor from the shortlists submitted by the corresponding authorities and organizations, in accordance with the composition established by the respective Assemblies or Councils, as applicable."

Ordinance No. 007 of 2005 empowers the Governor of the Departmental Archipelago to convene and elect new members of the Departmental Planning Council from the shortlist of three candidates, provided that the sectors specified in the ordinance are not represented.

Whereas, upon expiration of the term established in Law 152 of 1994 for the service period of the members of the Departmental Planning Council, the following vacancies are found:

1. Three (3) representatives from the economic sector.
2. Two (02) representatives of farmers' organizations.
3. One (1) representative of informal workers.
4. One (01) representative of the Federation of Parents' Associations of Public Educational Institutions.
5. One (01) representative of Private Educational Institutions.
6. One (01) representative of Environmental NGOs.
7. One (1) representative from the Raizal community of San Andres.
8. One (1) representative from the Association of Architects and Engineers of San Andres.
9. One (01) representative of the fishing cooperative sector of San Andres.
10. One (1) representative from the Rural Development Council.
11. Two (02) representatives from the Municipal Planning Council (Providencia).

In order to comply with the constitutional and legal mandates related to the formation and operation of the Departmental Planning Council, it is necessary to issue a call for applications to fill the vacancies of its members.

Whereas, in view of the foregoing,

RESOLVES

FIRST ARTICLE: The corresponding authorities, groups, sectors, civil organizations, and citizens in general at the departmental level, legally recognized and wishing to be represented on the Departmental Planning Council, are hereby invited to submit their lists of three candidates, due to vacancies that have not been filled in previous calls, the renewal of council members, and the expiration of constitutional terms. Therefore, it is necessary to ensure adequate citizen participation in accordance with Article 342 of the Political Constitution and Departmental Ordinance No. 007 of 2005, from the following sectors:

1. Three (3) representatives from the economic sector.
2. Two (02) representatives of farmers' organizations.
3. One (1) representative of informal workers.
4. One (01) representative of the Federation of Parents' Associations of Public Educational Institutions.
5. One (01) representative of Private Educational Institutions.
6. One (01) representative of Environmental NGOs.
7. One (1) representative from the Raizal community of San Andres.
8. One (1) representative from the Association of Architects and Engineers of San Andres.
9. One (01) representative of the fishing cooperative sector of San Andres.
10. One (1) representative from the Rural Development Council.
11. Two (02) representatives from the Municipal Planning Council (Providence).

SECOND ARTICLE: Relevant Considerations:

1. The groups, sectors, civil organizations, and/or citizens in general that decide to nominate one or more candidates must have duly granted legal status.
2. The groups, sectors, civil organizations, and/or citizens, at the time of participating, must demonstrate a relationship between the development of their social purpose and the sector they intend to represent.
3. The groups, sectors, civil organizations, and/or citizens in general may not submit more than one shortlist representing the same sector.
4. The organizations from each sector shall be responsible for submitting the required documentation together with the shortlist.
5. You must comply with the requirements established in Decree 2284 of 1994 for the submission of lists of candidates in the following manner:

PARAGRAPH: For the candidate:

1. The nominee must demonstrate their connection with activities related to the sector they intend to represent.
2. The nominee must have technical knowledge and experience in matters related to the sector to be represented.

THIRD ARTICLE: In accordance with the provisions of Decree 1082 of 2015, the following documentation must be attached for the presentation of the slates of nominees:

1. The candidates' résumés (CVs), together with all supporting documents and attachments.
2. Letter of acceptance of the nomination by the candidates.

- 3. Letter from the nominating organization indicating the sector it represents, as well as the candidates' experience and/or affiliation with that sector.
- 4. Certificate of legal existence and representation, or a certificate of the organization's legal status, issued by the competent authority.
- 5. Copy of the minutes of the meeting at which the nomination was made.
- 6. Document explaining the representativeness of the nominating institution or institutions.
- 7. Identification and contact information for both the nominating organization and the candidates, including address, email, and telephone number.

PARAGRAPH: Organizations that belong to more than one sector may submit only one list of nominees. In all cases, the nominating organization must explicitly indicate the sector it represents.

The required documents may be submitted either in person to the Archive and Correspondence Office (Coral Palace Building, 1st Floor) or by the following institutional email: planeacion@sanandres.gov.co

The Governor will verify compliance with the requirements set forth in this call and, at her sole discretion, will appoint the new members of the Departmental Planning Council through an administrative act.

FOURTH ARTICLE: The deadline for organizations to submit candidates' résumés (CVs) and supporting documents is August 24, 2026, by 5:00 p.m. The submitted documents will be reviewed by the Secretariat of Planning, which will communicate the evaluation results to the Governor. The Governor will then appoint the members of the Departmental Planning Council in accordance with the following schedule.

Under this call, the selected candidates of the Departmental Planning Council will serve from 2026 through the 2034 term.
