

**OPEN CALL FOR PROJECT HOMES OF TEMPORARY HOMES OF SUB FAMILY MODALITY FOR PROVISIONAL CARE FOR CHILDREN AND ADOLESCENTS IN THE PROCESS OF RESTORING THEIR RIGHTS**

- **Those who wish to be part of this initiative must have space at home to accommodate a maximum of four children or adolescents.**
- **The person directly responsible for the service must have full-time availability during the week and weekends.**

San Andres Island, November 1, 2023. Providing excellent conditions to children and adolescents is essential for the 'All for a New Beginning' administration. Under this premise, the call 'Implementation of transition homes of sub family modality for the provisional care of children and adolescents in processes of restoration of rights in the Departmental Archipelago of San Andres, Providence, and Santa Catalina' is opened, an initiative that seeks to provide a place for minors who are going through processes of vulnerability of their rights.

Transition homes under the family modality are a provisional and initial placement modality of care 24 hours a day, maximum 8 business days a week, for the immediate placement of minors in a family while the administrative authority decides what the measure of restoration of rights most suitable for them, based on their best interests.

**REQUIREMENTS TO APPLY FOR THE PROJECT:**

1. Be between 23 and 60 years of age.
2. Have a minimum of ninth grade certificate educational level.
3. Demonstrate verifiable economic income of one (1) or two (2) minimum wages.
4. The person directly responsible for the service must have full-time availability during the week and weekends.
5. The person directly responsible for the service and/or spouse must be in good physical and mental condition, certified by a duly registered doctor.
6. None of the family members must have a criminal record.
7. Have space in the home to accommodate a maximum of 4 children or adolescents. Includes group of siblings.
