

OCCRE CARD WILL BE AN ESSENTIAL DOCUMENT TO VOTE IN THE DEPARTMENT ON OCTOBER 29th.

San Andres Island, October 19, 2023. From the Departmental Administration, headed by the Ad Hoc Governor of the Departmental Archipelago of San Andres, Providence, and Santa Catalina, Andres Rene Chaves Fernandez, it is clarified that for the upcoming election, scheduled for Sunday, October 29, 2023, it will be a fundamental requirement that citizens of the islands who will exercise their right to vote in the island territory present their Occre card along with their I.D. document.

The announcement is made with the objective of continuing to provide the necessary guarantees to all parties, movements, candidates, and significant groups, as well as to the institutions, in accordance with the limits established in Article 5, Numeral 4 of Decree Law 2762 of 1991.

Likewise, it is made clear, for the tranquility of the entire population of the Departmental Archipelago of San Andres, Providence, and Santa Catalina, that the Occre card will be a requirement in order to enter the different voting stations and exercise the right to vote, as it has been habitual over the years, since its entry into force.

We are inviting the community to pay attention to the official channels where all the details or changes that may arise will be announced.

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
