

OUT OF RESPECT FOR CONFIDENTIALITY, THE GOVERNMENT WILL NOT DISCLOSE INFORMATION SUBSCRIBED IN THE OCCRE DATABASES, FOR THE 2023 ELECTIONS

San Andres Island, October 23, 2023. The Residence Control and Circulation Office (OCCRE), is pleased to inform the community that the delivery of the information from the database for the relevant crossing with the National Electoral Census was sent to the National Registrar's Office of Civil Status since July 1, 2023, considering this first action as a test.

On the other hand, the delivery made on August 1st, as well as the two additional ones carried out in the month of October, were recorded, as appears in the receipt certificate issued by the National Registry.

Likewise, on July 25, the Departmental Delegates of the National Registrar in San Andres and Providence, the ICT Secretary and the director of the Office of Control and Circulation of Residence (OCCRE) signed the **COMMITMENT OF CONFIDENTIALITY AND NON-DISCLOSURE** of this basis, in order to comply with the provisions of Article 48 of Law 1475 of 2011 "by which rules of organization and operation of political parties and movements in electoral processes are adopted."

The same agreement indicates that the legal reserve and the sensitive nature maintained by the information incorporated in the databases produced and administered by the Government of the Archipelago of San Andres, Providence, and Santa Catalina complies with Statutory Law 1581 of 2012 "by which general provisions are issued for the protection of personal information", in title VI with respect to the duties of those responsible and in charge of processing the information.
